

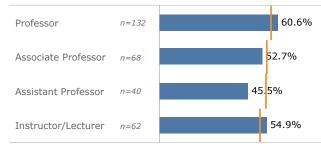

ABOUT THE SURVEY

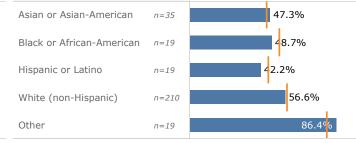
The Collaborative on Academic Careers in Higher Education (COACHE) *Faculty Job Satisfaction Survey* was administered to all Emory full-time faculty members in the spring of 2023 in partnership with COACHE. Approximately <u>38%</u> of Emory University faculty members completed the survey. However, **Emory's response rate excluding the School of Medicine is <u>55%</u>**. Emory's participation in COACHE advances strategic priorities relating to Pillars 1 and 2 of the *university strategic framework*, and it captures many of interests identified by faculty in the *Class & Labor II* report.

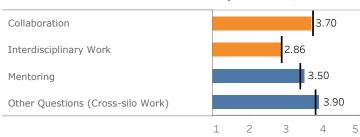

Tenure and Promotion: 38% response rate

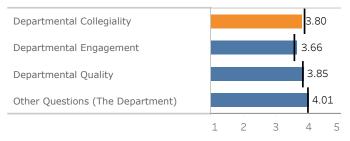

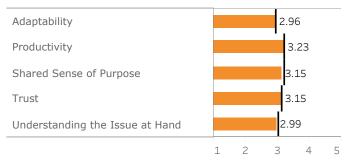

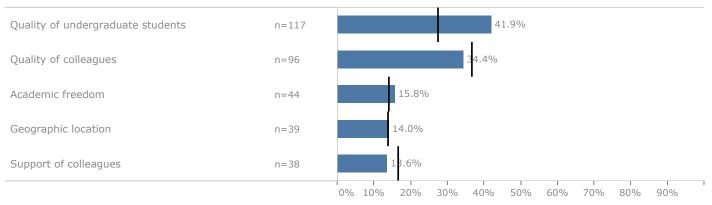

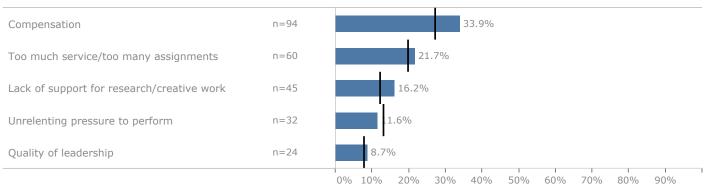
